

UČITELÉ, UČME (SE) BEZ HRANIC! at Pedagogical and grammar school in Přerov, Czech Republic

Dear eTwinning teachers,

Last week our first project Erasmus+ KA101 ended. As it was fantastic experience we would like to share it with you.

The project included eight mobilities – four language courses, three job-shadowings and one teaching and focused on learning languages, innovative teaching methods and inclusion.

And what benefits did it result in? We improved and modernised our teaching methods (education via apps such as *kahoot* or *plickers*, *caviardage*, brainstorming, mind maps, peer teaching, project teaching, KA2 projects, using authentic materials prepared by teachers etc.), which also led to the increase in motivation of our students (especially in Maths and Science) and their interest in European projects. We also updated our European school development plan. Our teachers successfully completed two eTwinning projects (*Learning skills* and *Warm-up Exercises to the National Music*). We organized an Art excursion into Paris and created a pocket Czech-French dictionary for it. We realised how important it is to educate the talented and disadvantaged students. We introduced specialised clubs to do that. Moreover, our school staff had a training on inclusion.

If you are considering applying next year, here are some tips for you what to do / not do:

- Choose your partners properly (eTwinning project may be the step towards a KA101 project!)
- Communicate with them via email, Skype or Facebook (the more, the better)
- Set the goals clearly
- Sign the mobility agreement before the mobility itself
- Use Europass Mobility or Europass Language Passport
- Don't forget to sign Mobility Confirmation Document
- Organize language course for participants who are not fluent in it
- Always pay attention to the safety
- Insure the participants and (air) tickets
- When problems occur contact your centre for cooperation in education

If you hesitate if to apply or not, believe me, it is worth it.
